During these last few months, the P2 and P3 classes will be focusing on Character Traits and why they are important. The traits we will focus on are... Compassion to Others, Courage, Faithfulness, Forgiveness, Generosity, Honesty, Joyfulness, Kindness, Loving, Patience, Respect and Self Control. Each week we will nominate a few children who have demonstrated one of these traits and they will become our “Sonshine’s Ray of Light” for the week! Each child will be given a certificate of recognition along with a yard sign that reads “Sonshine’s Ray of Light” to be placed in front of your home for the week.

We look forward to reinforcing the behaviors your children have been working on this year, celebrate with us as we recognize exceptional performers!
