These skills help promote a range of positive behaviors, beginning before they enter kindergarten and extending into adult life. During these last few months, the P2 and P3 classes will be focusing on Character Traits and why they are important. The traits we will focus on are... Compassion to Others, Courage, Faithfulness, Forgiveness, Generosity, Honesty, Joyfulness, Kindness, Loving, Patience, Respect and Self Control.

Each week we will nominate a few children who have demonstrated one of these traits and they will become our “SonShine’s Ray of Light” for the week! Each child will be given a certificate of recognition along with a yard sign that reads “SonShine’s Ray of Light” to be placed in front of your home for the week.

We look forward to reinforcing the behaviors your children have been working on this year, celebrate with us as we recognize exceptional performers!

Read, Read Read!

When parents ask teachers about advice on helping their children, most would say, “read, read, read!” Research tells us that one of the best ways to ensure that children become good readers is to read to them. Children need to be read to daily, reading a story with your child every day is a good habit to form. Choosing from a wide variety of books also broadens your child’s reading

After reading the story, ask your child, “What did you like best about the story?.. Would you have ended the story differently?” Choosing questions to ask your child about books you read depends on your child’s interests.

Remember, you can’t read too much to your child!
